


• Most American commuters drive alone in their own cars.


• The U.S. has more cars per 1000 people than other countries. *Why do you think India has so few cars per 1000 people?*

• U.S. drivers make a lot of short trips.


Use the chart to determine the percentage of all trips that are three miles or less.



Car Trip Distance Distribution (n = 748,918)








